product line that includes a new line of economy replacement windows, a full DP 50 program and new product options such as clay and bronze exteriors. The company is also adding casements, awnings and sliding glass doors to its Sherwood wood replacement product line incorporating Veka's Timberview technology. Vinylmax sells windows and doors to distributor customers, providing three-day lead times from the East Coast to the Rockies. Other plans for 2008 include the introduction of a new Internet-based order management system for customers and a new multi-media marketing program. Vinylmax advances from the \$20 million to \$30 million sales range category to the \$30 million to \$40 million level this year.
